

PUPPY SHOPPING LIST

PUPPY BED Pro Tip: HomeGoods has a great selection under \$25.00
PUPPY CRATE – A PLACE TO SLEEP OR STAY WHILE FAMILY IS AWAY
BED MAT FOR CRATE Pro Tip: Buy 2 in case they have an accident
PLAY PEN Pro Tip: If you have adult dogs at home then, while your baby is little and until they become friends you should have a PROTECTED area for your puppy to play in and be safe.
POTTY AREA FOR PLAY PEN Pro Tip: Weasy System is great for this
INDOOR POTTY TRAINING Comes in your puppy pack
FOOD BOWL Pro Tip: Raised and slanted feed bowl is BEST for Frenchie's.
WATER BOWL Pro Tip: Raised STAINLESS STEEL INTERIOR water bowl or WATER FOUNTAIN SYSTEM
DOG FOOD Small bag (3.5lbs) comes in your puppy pack
PROBIOTIC AND VITAMINS 10-day Sample comes in your puppy pack
CHEW TOYS/BUTCHER MEAT BONES Pro Tip: Do NOT buy sticks! Only round (circle) bully chew toys. Sticks (straight chews) are a danger to Frenchie's Eyes. I had to learn this the hard way! DO NOT allow two dogs to chew bones in the same space this will lead to a dog fight! Keep them separated! NOT EVEN IF THEY LOVE EACHOTHER
COLLAR and HARNESS + LEASH Baby puppies should only wear a collar when learning how to walk on a leash. Dogs 16 weeks and older can wear a collar at all times if you choose to do so. Harnesses are the better choice for walking to protect the airways of your brachycephalic dog. Pro Tip: Regular leashes are better than retracting leashes Retracting long leashed can cause trauma if dropped while not in a locking position and it may be difficult to get your pup to walk on a leash again.
CAR SEAT Baby puppies should be held or in a portable soft carrier. Dogs 16 weeks (10lbs) thru adulthood should have a car seat for ALL car rides PRO TIP: FRENCHIE'S LOVE CAR RIDES
